- Take part in extracurricular activities; school and/or community service.
- Financial Need considered

B. Candidates who qualify must:

- Complete the application and submit it no later than <u>March 28, 2018</u> to your high school Guidance Office.
- Write an essay of no more than 500 words (must be typed) on your future career choice. Be sure to include who or what influenced your decision.
- Letter of recommendation from student's school counselor, who must be a member of the High School Counselors Association of Western New York.
- Official high school transcript including 1st semester senior grades.
- C. Scholarship is a \$500.00 check made out to the student. **NOTE:** The scholarship is designated to be used for non-tuition college expenses such as room and board, books or fees. The student will receive the scholarship in June 2018.
- D. Individual schools will have the responsibility of selecting a student who meets the academic, extracurricular and career/post secondary goals stated in the criteria. Only one student from each high school should be forwarded to the scholarship committee by 4/23/18 in care of:
